## Important Documents to Bring

After you've scheduled an appointment with Paoli or Tredyffrin Library, you will need to bring the following documents with you:

- Copy of previous year tax return. If necessary, contact the IRS for a copy of last year's return. (See below)
- W-2 forms from each employer
- All 1099 forms (1099-INT, 1099-DIV, 1099-misc., etc.) showing interest and/or dividends as well as documentation showing the original purchase price of your sold assets
- If you were paid Social Security benefits, bring your SSA-1099
- If you received a pension or annuity, bring your 1099R
- All forms indicating federal income tax paid
- If applicable, unemployment compensation statements
- Child care provider information (name, employer ID, SSN)
- If itemizing deductions, bring all receipts or canceled checks for items such as medical expenses, taxes paid, mortgage interest paid, and charitable contributions
- Social Security numbers for all dependents

**Need a Copy of Your Tax Return Information?** You have two easy and convenient options for getting copies of your federal tax return information--tax return transcripts and tax account transcripts--by phone or by mail. Request transcripts by calling 1-800-829-1040, or order by mail using IRS Form 4506T (*Request for Transcript of Tax Return*) found on [www.IRS.gov](http://www.IRS.gov). There is no fee for transcripts. Allow two weeks for delivery.
